Rest stops along the way:

To avoid getting off the highway for bathroom breaks, there are 2 rest stops along highway 8.

- The **Buckman Springs Rest Area** is located near mile marker 51, about 3.3 miles East of Pine Valley, CA.
- The **Jaime Obeso Sunbeam Rest Area** is located about 6 miles west of El Centro mile marker 108
